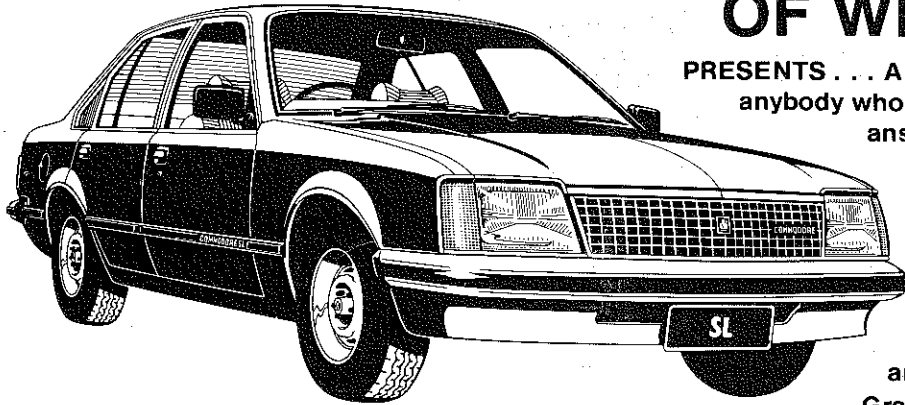


WERRIBEE RIFLE CLUB Inaugural Prize Meeting

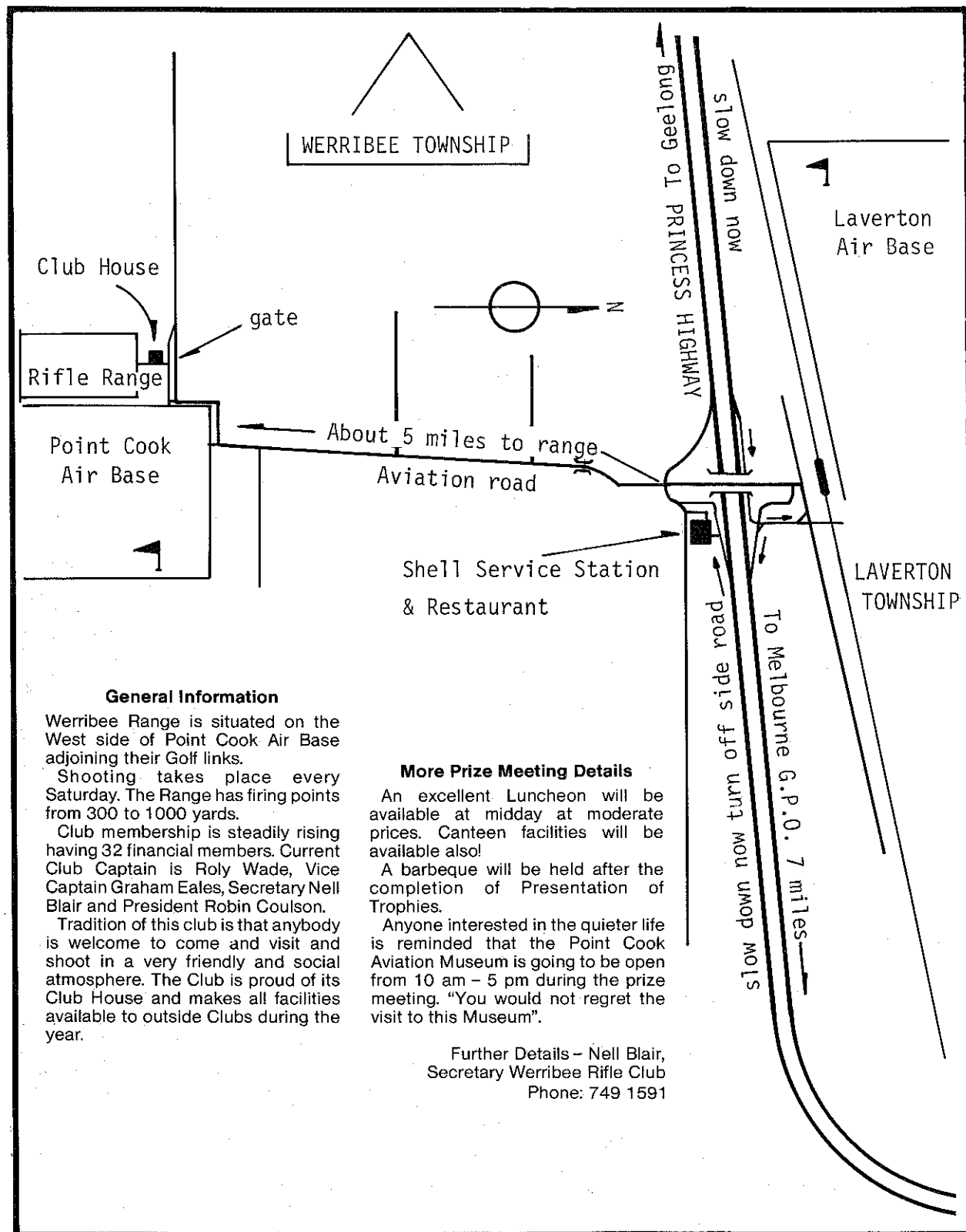
